#### DISCUSSION:

Patty Blocksom reported that informal discussions are being held about a possible mural for the Hanna Legion. General consensus is that this would be a great addition to our local murals and many individuals may be interested in donating towards such a project. Members will consider how Hanna in Bloom might be of assistance to this project for the future.

## **DISCUSSION:**

- Sandra Beaudoin presented the idea of a park being developed on the CN land where the original station was located. This site is approximately one block in size and would require landscaping. CN has been contacted and they have indicated they would rent the property for \$2,500 annually.
- ➤ It was felt that this was outside the ability of the Hanna in Bloom committee to undertake a project of this size.
- It was suggested that the first step would be to ensure that the property is maintained and kept clean of debris and weeds.

## **HANNA LODGE PROJECT:**

- ➤ Pam Berry reported that she has been working with several residents at Hanna Lodge who are interested in making planter spikes and centerpieces.
- > Town of Hanna Community Services department will cover the costs associated with supplies and the volunteers will construct the spikes.
- > They are looking at winter and spring themed ideas.
- > These will greatly enhance the barrels in the community.
