

**TOWN OF HANNA
PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
BY-LAW 973-2014**

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF HANNA, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO PROVIDE FOR AN AMENDMENT OF THE HANNA TRAFFIC BYLAW NO 936-2007.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act and the Traffic Safety Act, the Council of the Town of Hanna has adopted the Hanna Traffic Bylaw 936-2007;

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it desirable to amend the Hanna Traffic Bylaw 936-2007 and amendments thereto;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HANNA, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, HEREBY AMENDS THE HANNA TRAFFIC BYLAW 936-2007 AS FOLLOWS:

PART I BYLAW TITLE

1. This bylaw shall be known as "The Hanna Traffic Bylaw 2014 Amendment"

PART II AMENDMENT

- 2.35 "Recreational Vehicle" means a vehicle used or intended for use as a shelter, and without restricting the generality of the foregoing, includes any motor-home, holiday trailer, camper or tent trailer.
- 2.36 "Regulations" means "The Use of Highway and Rules of the Road Regulation" (A.R.304-2002) made pursuant to the Act.
- 2.37 "Roadway" means that part of the highway intended for the use by vehicular traffic.
- 2.38 "Safety Zone" means a space designated by a marking or a device placed upon the surface of a highway dividing the highway for traffic moving in opposite directions and intended as a pedestrian area.
- 2.39 "Sidewalk" means that part of a highway especially adapted to use of or ordinarily used by pedestrians, and includes that part of the highway between
 - 2.39.1 The curb line, or
 - 2.39.2 Where there is no curb line, the edge of the roadway, and the adjacent property line whether or not it is paved or improved.
- 2.40 "Special highway event" means an event or competition, taking place in whole or in part on a highway involving walking, running, or the use of bicycles, motorcycles, cars or other vehicles.
- 2.41 "Stop" means:
 - 2.41.1 When required, a complete cessation of vehicular movement; and
 - 2.41.2 When prohibited, any halting, even momentarily, of a vehicle whether occupied or not except when necessary to avoid conflict with other

traffic or in compliance with the direction of a Peace Officer or a traffic control device.

- 2.42 “Temporary Parking Permit” means a permit to allow for the extension of the 24 hour parking restriction for recreational vehicles and trailers to a maximum of 7 days as specified in Schedule “I” and forming part of this Bylaw. A Temporary Parking Permit will be issued at the discretion of the Chief Administrative Officer.
- 2.43 “Town” means the Town of Hanna.
- 2.44 “Traffic” means pedestrians, animals, or vehicles while using the highway for the purpose of travel.
- 2.45 “Traffic control device” means a parking meter, a sign, a signal, a traffic island, marking or a device marked or erected under the authority of the Act or of this Bylaw for the purpose of regulating, warning or guiding traffic.
- 2.46 “Traffic control signal” means a traffic control device whether manually, electrically or mechanically operated by which traffic is directed to stop and to proceed.
- 2.47 “Traffic Tag” means:
2.47.1 A municipal violation tag; or
2.47.2 A tag authorized by the Provincial Offences Procedures Act and issued pursuant to Section 2.1 of this Bylaw.
- 2.48 “Trailer” means a vehicle so designed that it may be attached or drawn by a motor vehicle and intended to transport property, persons or animals.
- 2.49 “Vehicle” means a device in, on or by which a person or thing may be transported or drawn on a highway.
- 2.50 “Abandoned Vehicle: means a vehicle that is an abandoned vehicle under section 69(8) or 76 of the Act.
- 6.22 No person shall park any recreational vehicle or trailer on a highway, except for the purpose of loading or unloading, for a period not exceeding forty eight (48) consecutive hours and only if it is located on that portion of highway that lies immediately adjacent to the property it is being loaded from or unloaded to, following which the person shall move the said vehicle to an off-street location for a period of not less than forty-eight (48) consecutive hours before said vehicle may be parked again in the same area of the street or alley; unless in possession of a Temporary Parking Permit.

PART III PENALTIES

- 23.3 Notwithstanding Section 23.1, where any person contravenes the same provision of this Bylaw for a second and subsequent offence the specified penalty payable in respect of the second and subsequent contravention is double the amount shown in Schedules A, B, C, D, E, & F of this bylaw in respect of that provision.
