Title: Sanitary Sewer Service Complaints Policy # 99-01

## Purpose:

To provide a consistent policy for dealing with sanitary sewer service problems and complaints from property owners.

## Statement:

Section 37(1) of the Municipal Government Act states:

The owner of a parcel of land is responsible for the construction, maintenance and repair of a service connection of a municipal public utility located above, on or underneath the parcel.

## Policy:

- All complaints or inquiries regarding sanitary sewers are to be directed to the Director of Public Works.
- The owner is responsible for costs related to any blockage caused by objects blocking flow in the line anywhere from the house to the main.
- Whenever possible the Town of Hanna will determine the cause of blockages with the use of a closed circuit camera. The Director of Public Works is the final authority in determining the cause of a blockage.
- Blockages caused by tree root intrusions are considered a unique situation and will be handled in the following manner:
  - The Director of Public Works will determine, if possible, the source of the tree roots and the portion of the line that is being affected by the root intrusion.
  - 2. If the source is located on Town Property the Town will take action to remedy the problem.
  - 3. If the source is located on the owners property the owner is required to remedy the problem.
  - 4. If the source is located on a neighboring property and the intrusion is on Town property the Town will take action to remedy the problem.

- 5. If the source is located on a neighboring property and the intrusion is on the owners property the owner may take whatever action (within the law) he feels is appropriate to remedy the problem.
- 6. If the source is undetermined, the Director of Public Works may take remedial action and negotiate any cost sharing with the home owner.
- The Town of Hanna will, as time permits make repairs caused by pipe failures from the <u>property line</u> to the main. The Town may assume the costs related to cleaning a blockage caused by pipe failure from the <u>property line</u> to the main.
- The Town of Hanna will not be responsible for any costs incurred prior to being notified of the problem even if the problem is caused by a pipe failure. (Due diligence)
- In all cases the Town does not assume any liability for costs related to clean up of sewer backup resulting from service connection blockages.
